Installation Tips

Before you begin installing this assembly, read all instructions thoroughly.

For a smooth fit:

For ease in installation, the product should be installed at temperatures above 72° F. Below this temperature, the fabric may contract an inch or more, making it difficult to fit to the vehicle. It is normal for fabric to contract and wrinkle when stored in the shipping carton. Within a few days after the installation, the fabric will relax and the wrinkles will disappear.

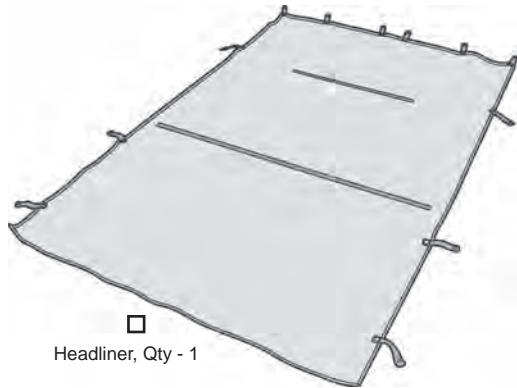

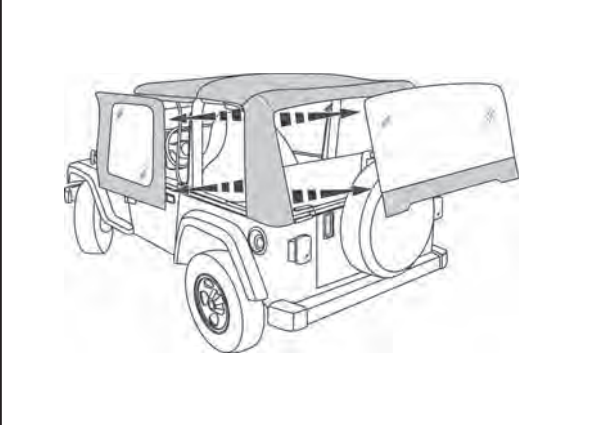
2 Release Top from Rear Bow

Remove the screws that secure the flaps in the top to the Rear Bow. Set them aside to be reinstalled later.



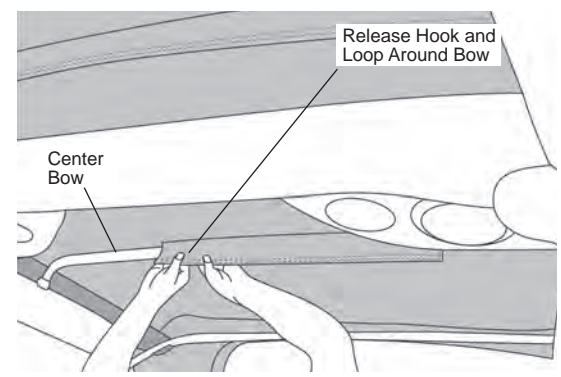
1 Remove Rear and Side Windows

Remove the Rear and Side Windows on the Top.



3 Release Top from Center Bow

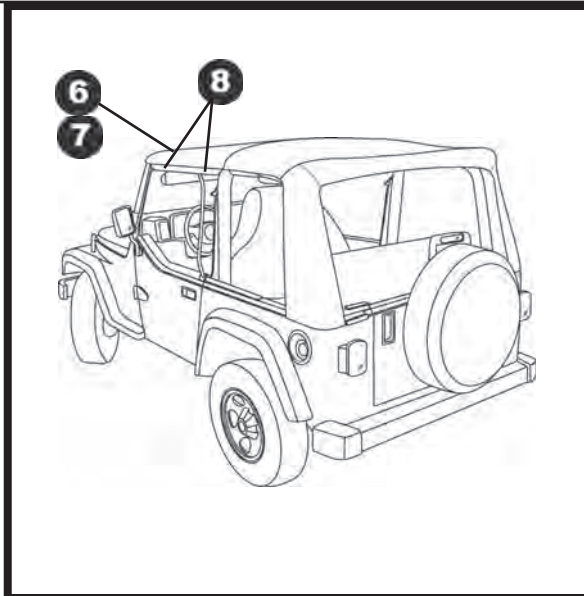
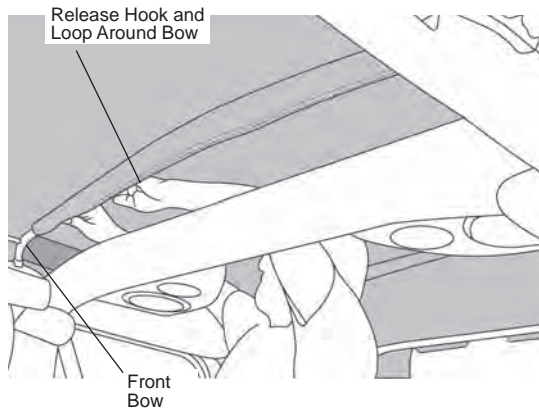
Release the hook and loop flap around the Center Bow.

4 Release Top from Front Bow

Release the hook and loop flap around the Front Bow.



7 Secure Headliner to Header

Center the Headliner on the vehicle. Fasten the loop strip sewn to the front of the Headliner to the Adhesive Hook Strip installed on the Header.



5 Expose Top of Header

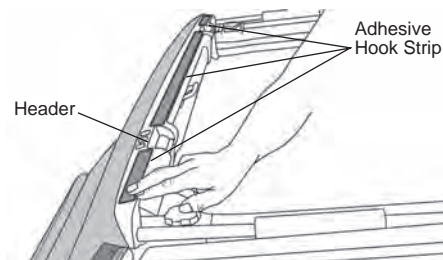
Fold the top fabric forward to expose the Header.



6 Install Adhesive Hook on Header

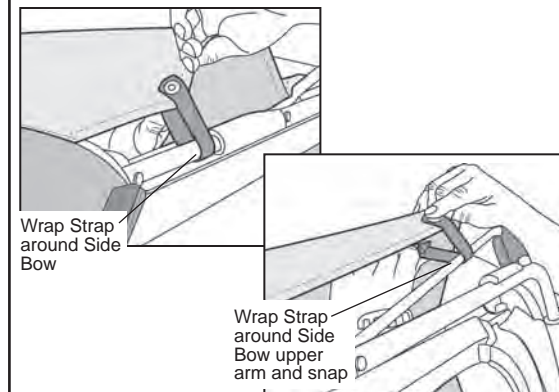
Cut three (3) pieces of Adhesive Hook Strip to fit along the Header. Peel the backing off the Adhesive Hook Strip and press it firmly into place on the Header as shown. Repeat on both sides of the vehicle.

NOTE Allow 72 hours for the adhesive to set. Avoid unnecessary fastening and unfastening of the Headliner during this period.



8 Secure Headliner Straps

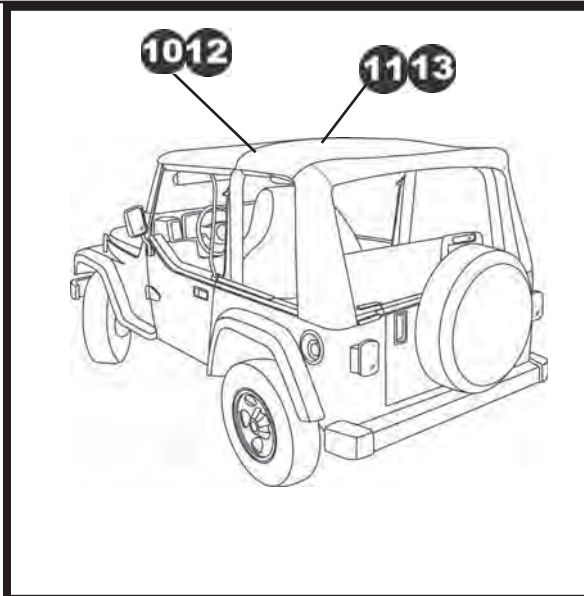
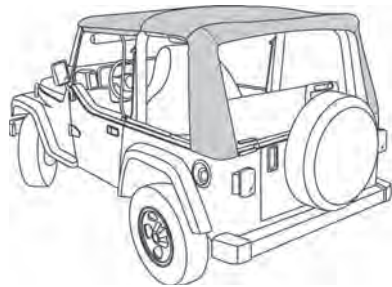
Wrap the two (2) front strap on the Headliner around the Side Bow and snap. Repeat on both sides.

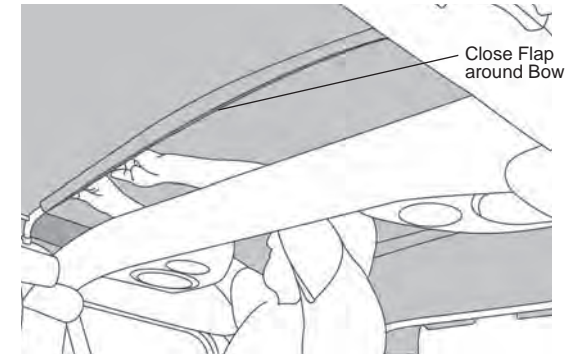
9 Drape Top Fabric over Bows

Fold the top fabric back over the bows.



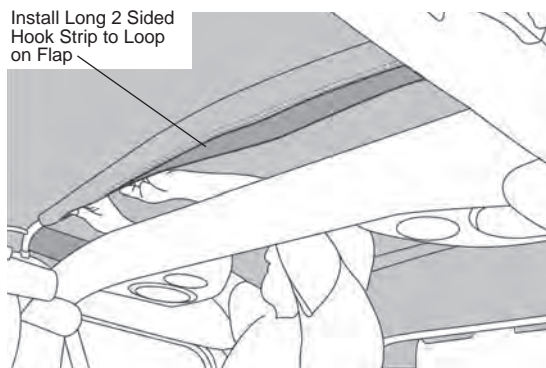
12 Secure Hook Flap around Front Bow

Close the flap and the 2 Sided Hook Strip around the Front Bow.



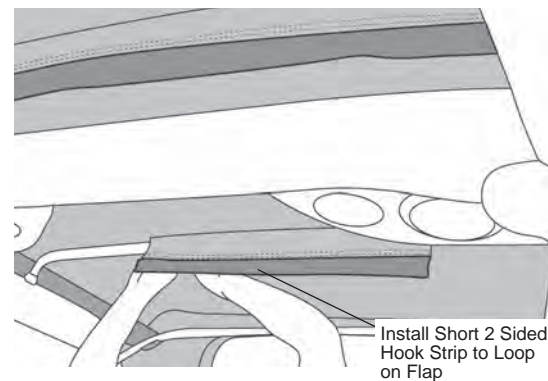
10 Install Long 2 Sided Hook Strip on Front Bow

Fasten the Long 2 Sided Hook Strip to the loop on the flap around the Front Bow.



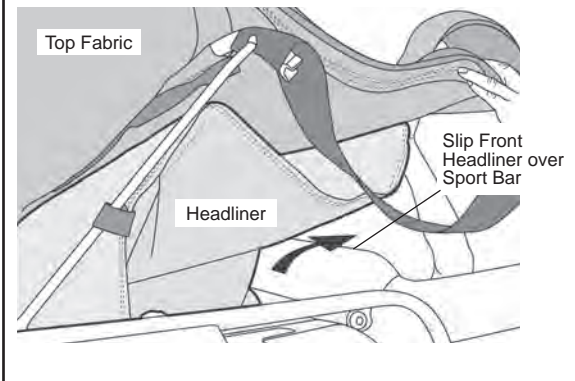
11 Install Short 2 Sided Hook Strip on Center Bow

Fasten the Short 2 Sided Hook Strip to the loop on the flap around the Center Bow.



13 Slip Headliner over Sound Bar

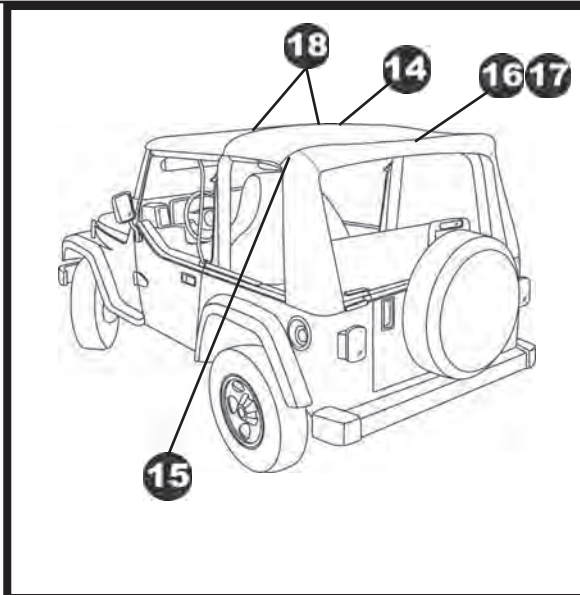
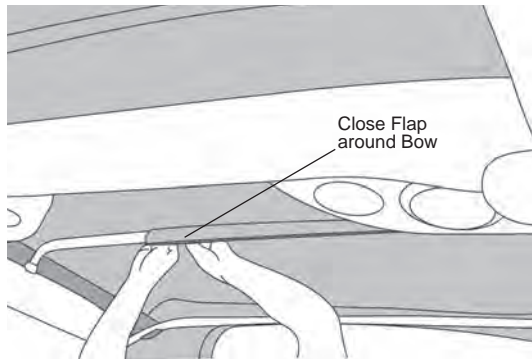
Slip the Headliner Fabric between the Sound Bar and the Top Fabric.

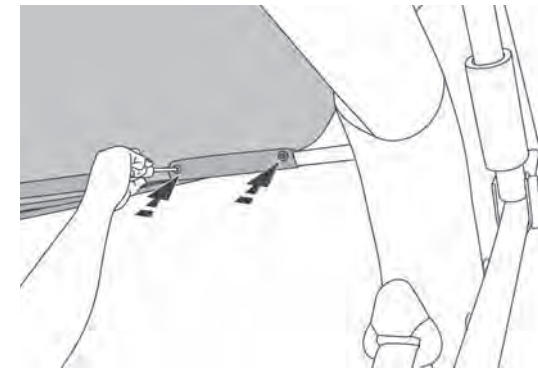
14 Secure Hook Flap around Center Bow

Close the flap and the 2 Sided Hook Strip around the Center Bow.



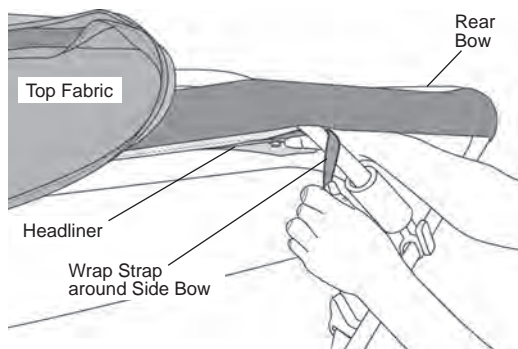
17 Secure Top Fabric to Rear Bow

Reinstall the screws that were removed in Step 2 to secure the flaps in the top to the Rear Bow.



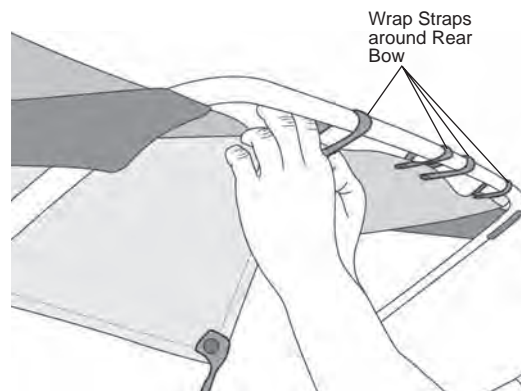
15 Secure Rear Side Headliner Straps

Wrap the strap on the side of the Headliner near the rear corner around the Side Bow and snap. Repeat on both sides.



16 Secure Headliner to Rear Bow

Wrap the rear straps on the Headliner around the Rear Bow and snap together.



18 Secure Headliner to Front and Center Bows

Press up on the Front Headliner to secure it to the Adhesive Hook Strip installed on the Front and Center Bows in Steps 10 and 11.



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Care and Maintenance of your Bestop Product

Your Bestop product is made of the finest materials available. To keep it looking new and for the maximum possible wear, it will need periodic cleaning and maintenance.

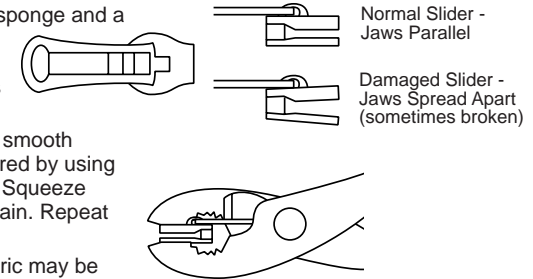
Washing: The fabric should be washed often using soap, warm water and a soft bristle brush. Rinse with clear water to remove all traces of soap or use Bestop-recommended Bestop Cleaner and Bestop Protectant. Bestop Cleaner and Bestop Protectant are specially formulated to provide a total cleaning and protection system. Bestop Cleaner will not harm vehicle finish, is biodegradable and environmentally friendly. Bestop Protectant protects against UV-fading, cracking and hardening.

Windows: Keep windows clean to avoid scratching. DO NOT use a brush on the windows! Wash with a water-soaked cloth or sponge and a mild dishwashing detergent or use Bestop-recommended Bestop Vinyl Window Cleaner, which safely cleans and protects vinyl windows while helping prevent UV damage. NEVER WIPE THE WINDOWS WHEN THEY ARE DRY. Be careful when cleaning snow or frost from the vinyl windows since they are easily scratched and may crack at low temperatures. DO NOT roll the sides or rear window in cold weather. The windows become stiff and will crack.

Zippers: Keeping the zipper cleaned and lubricated with a silicone lubricant will help prevent damage and keep the zippers in a smooth working condition. If a zipper opens behind the slider, the slider may have been spread apart. This problem can usually be repaired by using an ordinary pair of pliers to bring the sides back into parallel. Return slider to the end of the zipper in the normal Open position. Squeeze lightly at first and test the zipper. If the zipper continues to remain open squeeze more firmly with the pliers and try the zipper again. Repeat this procedure until the zipper operates correctly.

Water: Seeping through at the seams may be stopped by applying 3-M Scotchgard® on the inside of the seams. Rips in the fabric may be repaired with Bondex® iron on patches. Iron the patches to the Inside of the top, carefully following the Bondex® instructions.

Snaps: Keep snaps cleaned and lubricated with silicone to help prevent snaps from sticking to the studs. If a snap does become stuck to a stud, use a screwdriver and GENTLY pry apart to prevent permanent damage to the snap or the top fabric.
