


## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

## EXHAUST INSTALLATION #619502

When installing this exhaust system make sure to use proper safety precautions. Use jack stands when under the truck, set parking brake, block tires and use safety glasses and gloves. DO NOT WORK WITH HOT PIPES!


## **SUGGESTED TOOLS:**

1/2", 9/16", 15mm Socket & Wrench, WD-40, Jack Stand, Hacksaw



Lay out the exhaust on the floor so it looks like the drawing and compare parts with manual. To remove the stock exhaust remove it from the clamp located just in front of the muffler. You may need to heat it up for easier removal. Leave all rubber grommets in place. Use WD-40 to aid in removal of exhaust and hangers.







Install head pipe # A front pipe and secure with clamp # I. Do not tighten.



on to your existing stock



Install band clamp # G into rubber grommets located just above the axle. Do not tighten. Attach with bolt kit #J.







Install the over axle tailpipe # C into the muffler 1-1/2" to 2". Secure to the muffler using clamp # H Do not tighten. You may need to loosen spare tire & push over towards driverside & re tighten. Next install exit pipe # D onto overaxle pipe insert hanger into rubber grommet. Use clamp # H to secure pipes together rotate to proper angle for your vehicle. DO NOT TIGHTEN.

Install stainless steel tip. Clamp down. When you have everything in place, firmly tighten all bolts and clamp down securely. To clean stainless steel tip use any stainless steel cleaner and Scotch Brite pad.

MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A 1" CLEARANCE ON ALL RUBBER BRAKE LINES, SHOCK BOOTS, TIRES, FUEL LINES, ETC..
