





DODGE Colt 1987-88 MITSUBISHI Mirage 1985-88



Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit. Remove the ashtray and (2) screws exposed. Unclip the gear shifter trim bezel and remove (4) screws exposed. Pop off the hazard switch and remove (1) screw exposed. Remove the dummy cap located below the brake lever and (2) screws exposed. Remove the screws securing the factory head unit and disconnect the wiring.




Snap the *Filler Bar* onto the *Equalizer Housing* and slide the assembly onto the bottom of the *Radio Housing*.



Pull the dash console assembly forward and disconnect the wiring. Remove (4) screws securing the radio trim bezel to the console and remove. Remove (4) screws securing the factory head unit and disconnect the wiring.




2-SHAFT HEAD UNITS: Attach the **Faceplate** to the **Radio Housing.** Slide the aftermarket head unit into the kit and secure with shaft nuts. (see Fig. A)

<u>DIN HEAD UNITS</u>: Cut and remove the shaft supports from the **Radio Housing**. Slide the DIN cage into the kit and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down. Slide the aftermarket head unit into the cage until secure. (see Fig. B)

(If an equalizer will be included, slide the unit into the back of the *Radio Housing* and secure. If an equalizer will NOT be included, snap the *Equalizer Dummy Plate* into the opening).



Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adaptor and making connections as shown. (Isolate and individually tape off the ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short circuit).



Re-connect the battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation. Mount the head unit/kit assembly to the sub-dash with those screws previously removed in step #1.
