



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Selection of an experienced installer is the sole responsibility of the project owner.

PREP THE BACK-UP KIT INSTALLATION BY PRE-INSTALL THE FLEX ERA 1 TO THE CORRESPONDING DRIVER AND PASSENGER SIDE LIGHT MOUNTS (AS SHOWN). NOTE: DUE TO THE ORIENTATION OF THE LIGHT, IF USING THE SPREAD BEAM, ROTATING THE LENS 90 DEGREES MAY BE REQUIRED FOR MORE DESIRABLE BEAM COVERAGE.



USING A T20 TORX, REMOVE THE FACTORY SCREWS FROM ONE SIDE OF THE CAMERA POD. USING THE SUPPLIED STAINLESS STEEL PHILLIPS SCREWS (#2 PHILLIP SCREW DRIVER) TO MOUNT THE FLEX ERA 1 LIGHT ASSEMBLY WITH MOUNT - MAKING SURE NOT TO OVER-TIGHTEN TO PREVENT STRRIPPING OUT THE PLASTIC THREAD BASE.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



REPEAT STEPS TO THE OTHER SIDE.



CONNECT BOTH LIGHTS TO THE SUPPLIED EXTENSION HARNESS AND SECURE THE LIGHT LEADS TO THE ZIP-TIE POINTS ON THE MOUNTING BRACKETS.



USING THE SUPPLIED ADHESIVE ZIP-TIE ANCHORS, RUN THE WIRE EXTENSION ALONG THE BACK-END OF THE REAR DRIVER-SIDE, DOWN THE DOOR SEAL.



CONTINUE TO ROUTE THE WIRE EXTENSION DOWN THE REAR DRIVER-SIDE DOOR SEAL, USING THE PROVIDE ADHESIVE ZIP-TIE ANCHORS.

USING A T-40 TORX, REMOVE THE BUMPER SCREW NEAR THE BOTTOM OF THE DOORWAY. With the fastener removed, tug on the bumper cover enough to run the 3-pin Harness connector to the underside of the vehicle.

ROUTE AND SECURE THE REST OF THE HARNESS (PER THE STANDARD BACK-UP LIGHT Harness instructions), securing the harness via zip-ties along the lower chassis following the dem harness along the driver-side of the vehicle.
