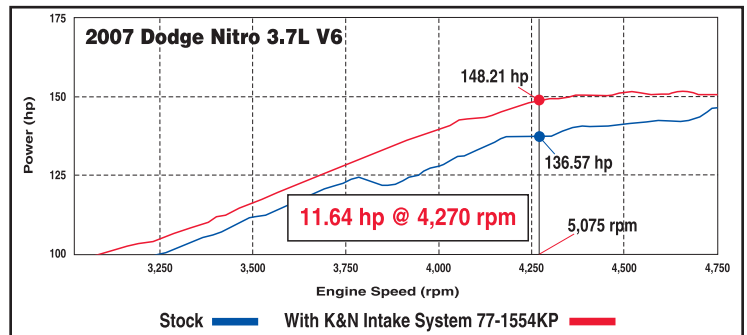
Dodge Nitro 3.7L V6 Gets 11 More Horsepower with K&N High-Flow Intake Systems

Two K&N High-Flow Intake Systems designed for the 2007 Dodge Nitro provide a choice of finishes – each increasing performance by more than 11 hp @ 4270 rpm for the 3.7L V6-powered SUV. Nitro drivers have the option between a polyethylene black intake tube with a peak hp increase of 11.7 (part no. 63-1554) or a polished metal intake tube with a peak hp of 11.64 (77-1554KP). To get a performance increase from both intake systems, K&N replaces the Nitro’s original intake assembly; including the air box, air filter and intake tube with an all-new intake design. The new system draws air through a K&N High-Flow Air Filter that increases airflow and filtering capacity and never needs to be replaced. Protecting the chrome top cone-shaped air filter, and isolating it from engine heat, is a powder coated steel heat shield that replaces the stock air box. As it passes the filter, air travels through a longer intake tube which utilizes a silicone hose to mount to the throttle body, eliminating the need for the Nitro’s OE intake plenum. Both new intake systems are designed to drive a more laminar flow of air to the engine, resulting in more horsepower.
