



Removal of Stock Exhaust:

CAUTION: ALLOW THE EXHUAST TO FULLY COOL BEFORE PERFORMING THIS INSTALLATION.

- 1. Remove the seat and side panels to access the front of the exhaust. **Refer to Figure 1**.
- 2. Loosen and remove the two (2) nuts and washers securing the flange at the inlet of the exhaust. **Refer to Figure 2**.
- 3. Remove the sensor from the stock exhaust.
- 4. In order to remove the exhaust, the shifter must first be temporarily moved. Remove the two bolts that hold the shifter in place to allow it to move outward. **Refer to Figure 3**.
- 5. Push the exhaust forward to free the inlet pipe, then slide the exhaust out from the rear, disengaging the hangers from the rubber isolators.

Installation of MBRP Exhaust:

- 1. Slide the **Muffler Assembly** into position, with the hangers going into the factory isolators from the front. **Refer to Figure 4**.
- 2. With the **Clamp** loosened and placed over the **Muffler Assembly** inlet, install the **Front Pipe**. With the **Front Pipe** in place and aligned to the **Muffler Assembly**, slide the **Clamp** over the **Inlet Pipe** flare and tighten it just enough to prevent movement.
- 3. Apply two (2) pieces of the supplied **Foil Tape** to the gas tank shield in the area closest to the **Front Pipe**, adjacent to the stock heat tape. **Refer to Figure 5**.
- 4. Reinstall the two (2) nuts and washers to secure the inlet flange. Verify the alignment of the **Muffler** and **Front Pipe**, then fully tighten the **Clamp** (35Nm).
- 5. Replace the exhaust sensor and reattach the shifter.
- 6. The third piece of **Foil Tape** can be applied to the inner rear fender in the area nearest to the exhaust pipe, if the stock foil is missing or damaged.
- 7. Replace the side panels and seat.

It is recommended that the muffler end cap screws be retightened (60 in-lbs /6.8 Nm) after the first ride and checked periodically thereafter, tightening if necessary.

Spark Arrestor Maintenance

In order to maintain optimal performance, the spark arrestor screen should be cleaned after the first 3 hours of use. Afterwards, clean every 30-35 hours of use.

Clean-out Instructions:

Make sure the vehicle is cool before completing the clean-out procedure.

- Using a 4mm hex key, remove the 4 screws securing the outlet cap or tip. `
 (Figure 1)
- 2. Remove the outlet cap to expose the spark arrestor screen insert. (Figure 2)
- 3. Remove the screen insert. (Figure 3)
- 4. Using a wire brush, thoroughly brush the screen to remove residue. (Figure 4)
- 5. Replace the screen and cap.
- 6. Tighten the screws to 60 in-lbs (6.8 Nm).
