





Removal of Stock Exhaust:

- 1. Remove the four (4) screws securing the rear cover to the muffler body, and remove the cover.
- 2. Remove and retain the two (2) bolts and springs securing the muffler inlet to the exhaust pipe. Leave the gasket on the exhaust pipe outlet.
- 3. Apply a silicone lubricant to the ends of the muffler hangers, then remove the muffler by sliding the hangers out of the rubber isolators.
- 4. Remove the OEM spark arrestor from the stock muffler outlet. The screw and spark arrestor will be reused on the new muffler.

Installation of MBRP Exhaust:

- 1. Remove the left-centre M6 screw from the chassis-mounted heat shield (in front of where the muffler was) Next, install the **Rubber Mount** in its place. **Refer to Figure 1.**
- 2. Put the **Muffler Assembly** in place by sliding the hanger rods into the rubber isolators.
- 3. Loosely connect the **Muffler Assembly** inlet flange to the exhaust pipe by reinstalling the previously removed springs and bolts with the supplied **Large Washers** (2) and **Nuts** (2). Do not fully tighten yet. **Refer to Figure 2.**
- 4. Secure the lower mount of the **Muffler Assembly** to the **Rubber Mount** using the provided **M6 Bolt, Flat Washer**, and **Lock Washer**. **Refer to Figure 3.**
- 5. Fully tighten the hardware at the inlet flange.
- 6. Install the OEM spark arrestor into the tip of the Muffler Assembly. Refer to Figure 4.

Note: In order to maintain optimal performance, the spark arrestor screen should be removed and cleaned after the initial 3 hours of use and then every 30-35 hours of use.

It is recommended that the muffler screws be retightened after the first ride and checked periodically thereafter, tightening if necessary.
