



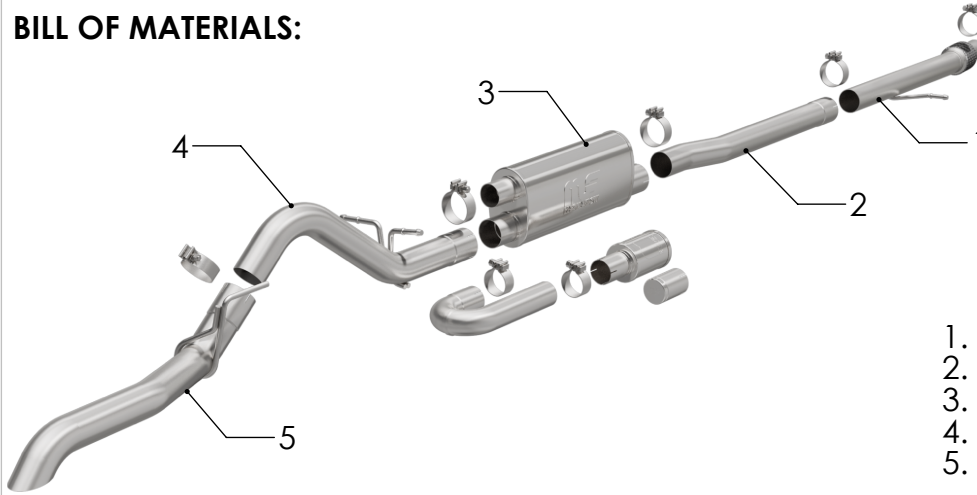

3. MUFFLER ASSY
4. OVER AXLE PIPE ASSY
5. TAILPIPE ASSY

READ INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLING PRODUCT



SPRAY LUBRICANT

To ease removal of existing exhaust components (especially on older vehicles) spray penetrating lubricant on all fasteners and hangers/insulators that will be loosened or removed and let soak before disassembly.

1. [4] 3.00" Clamp
2. [3] 2.50" Clamp
3. [1] Pipe Cap

13mm, 15 mm

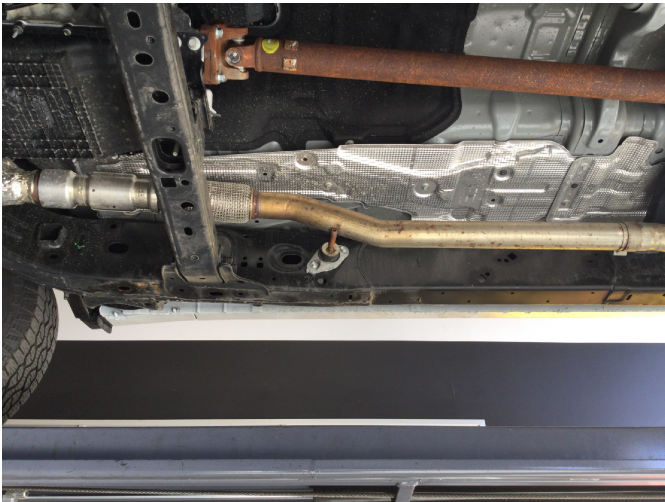
WARNING: When working on, under, or around any vehicle exercise caution. Please allow the vehicle's exhaust system to cool before removal, as exhaust system temperatures may cause severe burns. If working without a lift always consult vehicle manual for correct lifting specifications. Always wear safety glasses and ensure a safe work area. Serious injury or death could occur if safety measures are not followed.

ATTENTION: Always install any supplied band or U-bolt clamps to the proper torque specifications of 40-45 ft-lb for band clamps and 30-35 ft-lb for U-bolt clamps. Over tightening will result in the clamps breaking and will NOT be warranted by MagnaFlow.

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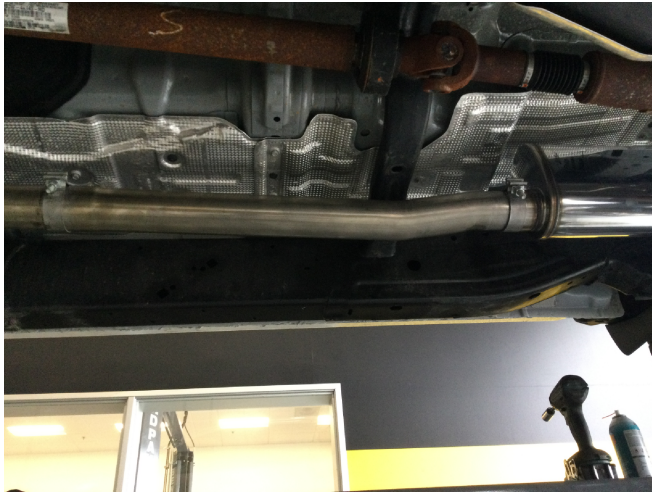


Step 1. To remove the OEM exhaust system disengage the welded hangers from the rubber insulators and remove the tailpipe assy. Unfasten the clamp attaching the OEM inlet pipe assembly to the catalytic converter. Do not damage or discard the rubber insulators as they will be re-used to mount the new system. Disengage the inlet pipe assembly hanger and remove the exhaust from the vehicle.

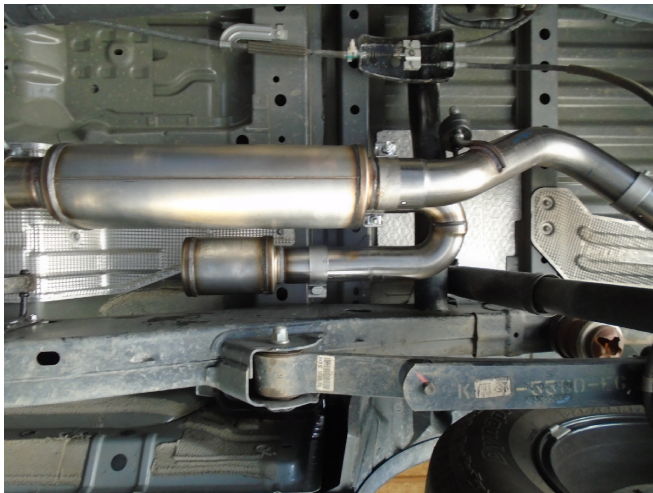
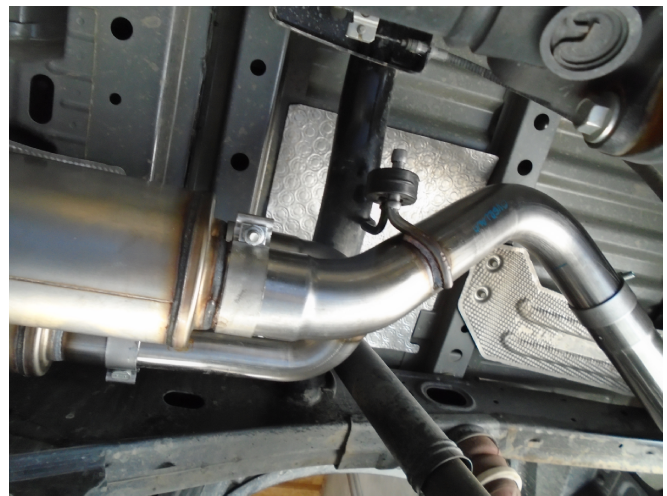


Step 2. To begin, loosely fasten the Inlet pipe assembly to the outlet of the OE catalytic converter using the Supplied clamp. Engage the welded hanger into the rubber insulator (Leave all clamps and fasteners loose for final adjustment of the complete system.)

Step 3. Next loosely attach the Inlet Extension Pipe Assembly to the Inlet Pipe Assembly using the supplied clamp. Engage the welded hanger to the rubber insulator.



Step 4. The Muffler is configurable to suit your sound and performance preference. Use the chart below as a guide. Install the Muffler inlet to the extension pipe outlet with the supplied clamp.



Step 5. Loosely install the Over Axle Pipe and Tail Pipe Assemblies locating the welded hangers to the rubber insulators and secure using the supplied clamps.

	<p>MOST AGGRESSIVE TONE: ONLY PIPE CAP</p>



Step 6. Once a final position has been chosen for the new exhaust system, evenly tighten all clamps from front to rear using the torque specifications on page one of the instructions. Inspect all fasteners after 25-50 miles of operation and re-tighten if necessary.
