



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

- 1. Chock the rear wheels and use a floor jack to lift the front of the vehicle. Place jack stands under the frame rails to support the vehicle.
- 2. Remove the front wheels.
- 3. Pull the cotter pin securing the upper ball joint. Loosen the nut to the upper ball joint with an XXmm wrench. Do not fully remove at this time. See Photo 1.
- 4. Strike the knuckle with a hammer to release the taper. See Photo 2.
- 5. Remove the upper ball joint with an XXmm wrench. Retain hardware for reuse.





- 6. Use two 19mm wrenches to remove the upper control arm bolts. Retain hardware for reuse. See Photo 3.
- 7. Remove factory upper control arm.
- 8. Install the supplied upper control arms in reverse order of disassembly using factory hardware.
- 9. Grease the ball joint before use. Check ball joint for grease every 3000 miles.



POST INSTALLATION

- 1. Check all fasteners for proper torque. Check to ensure there is adequate clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed and heated members. Check steering for interference and proper working order. Test brake system.
- Perform steering sweep. The distance between the tire sidewall and the brake hose must be checked closely. Cycle
 the steering from full turn to full turn to check for clearance. Failure to perform inspections may result in component
 failure.
- 3. Re torque all fasteners after 500 miles. Visually inspect components and re torque fasteners during routine vehicle service.
- 4. Readjust headlights to proper settings.
- 5. Vehicle will have to have a front-end alignment.
