


PROCEDURE

 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.




- 2. Remove all electrical connections from the rear bumper.
- 3. Remove the two nuts and two bolts on each side of the rear bumper. See Figure 1-2
- 4. Remove support tubes on both sides of the bumper.
- 5. Remove the rear bumper.






- 6. Install parking sensors by inserting into the holes on bumper and pressing with sensor L-tabs against bumper plate. Fasten L-tabs with the supplied M6 hardware (15, 17-19). **See Figure 3.**
 - Note: Be sure to maintain the orientation of the sensor so that it remains consistent with its original orientation.
- 7. Tighten M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs. *Note: if sensors are not equipped, install the supplied sensor plugs into the holes.*







8. **If blind spot monitor is equipped**— Remove the blind spot monitor from the OE bumper. Remove the cover on the bumper and install the monitor. See **Figure 5**.

If blind spot monitor is not equipped- Leave cover attached on bumper and proceed to the next step.



9. Using the supplied M12 hardware, loosely install bumper brackets on to the bumper. Then loosely assemble the bumper to the frame brackets. **See Figures 6-7**.






10. Install the Trailer plug and license plate.


WARNING.

After you have mounted bumper on main brackets. CAREFULLY open tailgate. While tailgate is open, adjust the height of the bumper so that it has about 3/8" of clearance with respect to the tailgate. Torque M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.




LIGHT INSTALLATION

- 1. Disconnect the battery from your vehicle.
- Locate the license plate lights (pre-installed) in the bumper. Pop out the lights by squeezing the clips in on the backside.
 See Figure 8
- 3. Locate the factory wiring for the license plate lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire. See **Figure 9**.







4. Push the light back in until it clips into place. Repeat on the opposite side. See **Figure 10**.



- 5. Remove the light from the rubber grommet. Install the rubber grommet into the back up light location on the bumper. Then, reinstall the light into the rubber grommet. See **Figures 11-12**.
- 6. Looking at the backside of the lower reverse lights, there are three wires: a ground wire, optional (off road only) tail light wire, and a reverse light (bright) wire. Using the figure below, connect the reverse light wire to the factory reverse light harness, and ground wire to a factory ground wire. If using the optional tail light wire, connect the Tail light wire to a switch. See Figure 12
- 7. Reconnect your battery.




